

Cossack Children's Art Awards 2022

Terms and Conditions of Entry

- A maximum of 200 artworks will be accepted for the Cossack Children's Art Awards 2022, with each category capped at a select number of entries. Entries for each category will close once the maximum entries have been received or by 4pm Friday 7 June 2022. No further entries will be accepted beyond this point;
- Categories are determined by age. Entrants will need to enter the relevant category for their age group:
 - 5-8 years
 - 9-11 years
 - 12-15 years
- The category should be based on the child's age as of 7 June 2022, the closing date for entries;
- All entries should be representative of the theme: **Pilbara Shapes or Formations**;
- Entry fee is \$20 per artwork and is non-refundable;
- Entries will only be accepted online via the Cossack Art Awards website or in person at the Red Earth Arts Precinct Box Office
- Each child can only enter ONE artwork and they must be living in the City of Karratha on a full time basis at the 12 May 2022;
- Upon confirmation of entry, each child will be provided with a 30x30cm canvas, collectable from the Box Office at Red Earth Arts Precinct, Welcome Road, Karratha WA from 12 May 2022. Please have your entry ticket confirmation with you when you go to collect your canvas. The Red Earth Arts Precinct Box Office is open from Monday to Friday 9.00am to 5.00pm and Saturday from 9.00am to 2.00pm;
- Only artworks displayed on the 30x30cm canvas provided to entrants will be accepted;
- When dropping off artwork, entrants must attach the entry form provided with the canvas. Failure to do so may result in the artwork not being accepted in the Awards.
- No artwork will be on sale throughout the exhibition dates 17 July 2022 to 7 August 2022;
- Copyright in all exhibited artworks will remain with the artist. It is a condition of entry that the entrant grants to the City of Karratha the right to freely use, communicate, reproduce and publish all exhibited works for publicity, promotional and educational purposes associated with the Cossack Art Awards in both digital and print mediums;

- Intellectual Property: the entrant warrants that they own the intellectual property rights in their submission and that any intellectual property rights and moral rights of a third party have not been infringed. The entrant must obtain the consent of persons featured in their submitted works for all marketing, educational and publicity uses of such works and ensure that additional consents or licences required in respect of names, trademarks, designs, works of art or any other intellectual property depicted in the work are obtained prior to entry;
- Insurance for artworks whilst in transit is the entrant's responsibility. Artworks are covered for fire and theft only whilst displayed in the exhibition. Any other insurance will be the responsibility of the entrant;
- Cossack Children's Art Awards artworks will be displayed in the Galbraith Building, Cossack, WA from Sunday 17 July to 7 August 2022;
- A judging panel will determine the winners of each category;
- Winners will be announced at the Children's Art Day event which will be held on Sunday 7 August 2022 and published on the Cossack Art Awards Facebook Page. All entrants will be invited to attend this event by email;
- There will be one winner in each age category, six Highly Commended Awards and one Overall Winner of the Cossack Children's Art Awards.
- The prizes for the Cossack Children's Art Awards are:
 - \$100 for each Category Winner (5-8 years, 9-11 years, 12-15 years)
 - \$50 for each Highly Commended Award
 - Overall Winner \$300 plus 20% discount on framing of the work at Dunnart

Artwork Drop-Off

- All works must be delivered directly by entrants or their parents/guardians to the Red Earth Arts Precinct Box Office, on Friday 17 June 2022 between 9.00am to 5.00pm or Saturday 18 June 2022 between 9.00am to 2.00pm.
- Please note that artwork will not be accepted at the Red Earth Arts Precinct and will not be accepted at Cossack at any time after Saturday 18 June 2022.

Artwork Collection

- Artwork must be collected by entrants or their parents/guardians on Friday 12 August 2022 between 5.00pm – 6.30pm or Saturday 13 and Sunday 14 August 2022 between 9.00am and 2.00pm from the BOND STORE at Cossack, WA. If artworks are not collected by 2.00pm Sunday 14 August they will be disposed of.
