

Cossack Children's Art Awards 2023

Terms and Conditions of Entry

- A maximum of 200 artwork will be accepted for the Cossack Children's Art Awards 2023, with 65 entries for 5-8 years and 9-11 years, 70 entries for 12-15years. Entries for each category will close once the maximum entries have been received or by 4pm Monday 6 June 2023, whichever comes first. No further entries will be accepted beyond this point;
- Categories are determined by age. Entrants will need to enter the relevant category for their age group:
 - 5-8 years
 - 9-11 years
 - 12-15 years
- The category should be based on the child's age at 6 June 2023, the closing date for entries;
- All entries should be representative of the theme: wasteland vs wonderland
- Entry fee is \$22per artwork and is non-refundable;
- Entries will only be accepted online via the Cossack Art Awards website or in person at the Red Earth Arts Prescient Box Office
- Each child can only enter ONE artwork and they must be currently living in the City of Karratha;
- All entrants must be Australian residents. An Australian resident is someone who holds a current permanent residency visa or is an Australian citizen. Those who hold a student visa, or any other visa that is not a permanent residency visa are not eligible to enter;
- Upon confirmation of entry, each child will be provided with an approved 30x30cm canvas. Please have you entry ticket confirmation with you when you go to collect your canvas. Canvas must be collected from the Red Earth Arts Precinct Box Office from Wednesday 5 April 2023, during opening hours. 9am-5pm weekdays and 9am – 2pm Saturdays.
- Only artwork displayed on supplied 30x30xm canvas will be accepted
- Entrants must label their artwork prior to drop-off at Cossack WA. Failure to do so may result in the artwork not being accepted in the Awards. Please label the back of the frame, do not write on the back of the canvas) with your
 - Full name
 - Age
 - Contact Number
 - Title of Artwork
- No artwork will be on sale throughout the exhibition dates; 23 July to 13 August 2023
- Copyright in all exhibited artworks will remain with the artist. It is a condition of entry that the entrant grants

to the City of Karratha the right to freely use, communicate, reproduce, and publish all exhibited works for publicity, promotional and educational purposes associated with the Cossack Art Awards in both digital and print mediums;

- Intellectual Property: the entrant warrants that they own the intellectual property rights in their submission and that any intellectual property rights and moral rights of a third party have not been infringed. The entrant must obtain the consent of persons featured in their submitted works for all marketing, educational and publicity uses of such works and ensure that additional consents or licences required in respect of names, trademarks, designs, works of art or any other intellectual property depicted in the work are obtained prior to entry;
- Insurance for artworks whilst in transit is the entrant's responsibility. Once delivered to the BOND STORE, Cossack, WA they are covered for fire and theft only. Any other insurance will be the responsibility of the entrant;
- Cossack Children's Art Awards Artworks will be displayed in the Galbraith Store, Cossack, WA from Sunday 23 July to Sunday 13 August 2023;
- A judging panel of three will determine the winners of each category;
- Winners will be announced at the Children's Art Day event which will be held on Sunday 13 August and published on the Cossack Art Awards Facebook Page. All entrants will be invited to attend this event by email;

- There will be 3 category winners, 3 x Highly Commended Awards and one Overall Winner of the Cossack Children's Art Awards.
- The prizes for the Cossack Children's Art Awards are:
 - \$100 for each Category Winner (5-8 years, 9-11 years, 12-15 years)
 - \$50 for each Highly Commended
 - Overall Winner \$300 plus 20% discount on framing of the work at Dunnart

Artwork Drop-Off

- All works must be delivered directly by entrants or their parents/guardians to the Red Earth Art Precinct Box Office, on Friday 7 July 2023 between 9.00am - 5.00pm or Saturday 8 July between 9.00am - 2.00pm.
- Please note that artwork will not be accepted at the Red Earth Arts Precinct and will not be accepted at Cossack at any time after Saturday 8 July 2023

Artwork Collection

- Artwork must be collected by entrants or their parents/guardians on Friday 18 August 2023 between 5.00pm - 6.30pm or Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 August 2023 between 9.00am and 2.00pm from the BOND STORE at Cossack, WA. If artworks are not collected by 2.00pm Sunday 20 August they will be disposed of.
